# The ERP Dilemma Facing Modern Enterprises

- **Rising license and renewal costs**
  - Many enterprises today are overpaying for rigid ERP systems that no longer match their operational agility requirements.
- **Vendor lock- in risks**
  - Many ERP vendors restrict data portability and integrations, making it difficult and expensive to switch providers.
- **Complex implementation cycles**
  - Large ERP deployments can take months or years, delaying value realization and increasing project risk.

- **Fragmented Systems Across Departments**

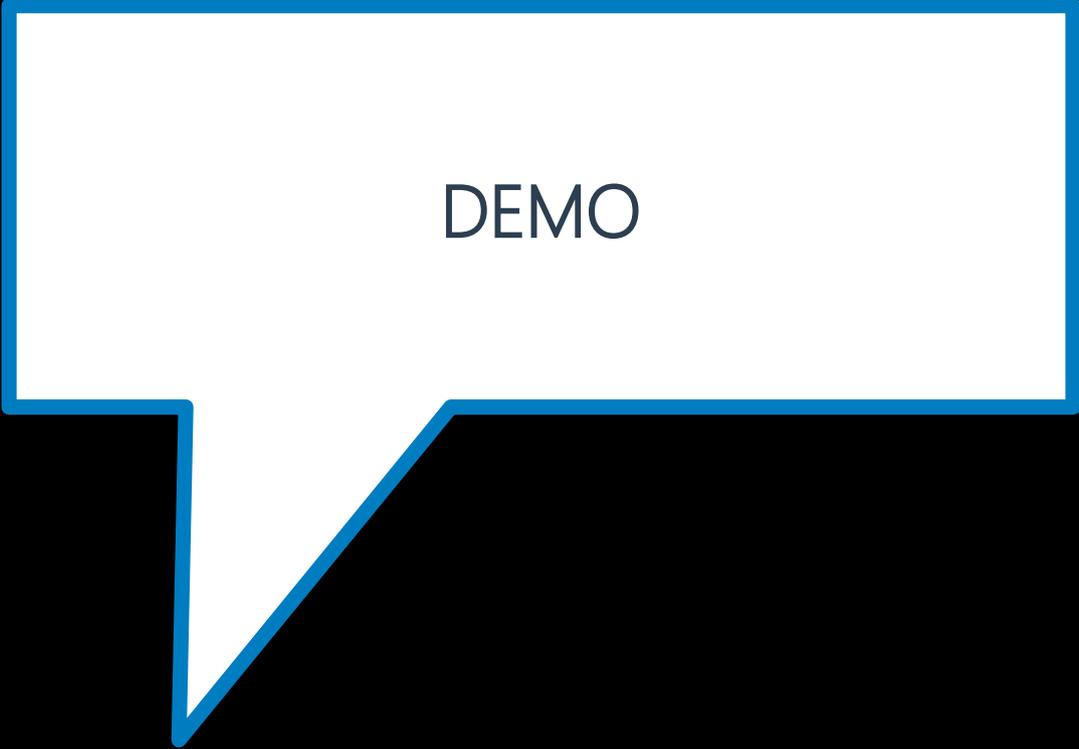
# Cost Comparison
